To all our Members, Spring is around the corner and it's almost time to think about planning the boating season. It's a good time of year to look over your safety equipment and see what additional equipment you may need, in order to have a safe and en-

joyable boating season. Each month our National Headquarters, sends out to all our members through email, safe boating tips through the **COMPASS**. It's got a lot of good information that we should all look over it. It's also a good time to start planning, if you're going on a boating vacation this year. I know our Past Commander Steve Burke is planning on a Boating Vacation with Friends from his Marina to Rhode Island. It looks like it's going to be a good trip.

In our Education Department, we are offering a one day ABC Course at the RIVERHEAD MOOSE LODGE on Sunday March 23, 2025 (See the Flyer). We will also have an ABC course in May at PORT OF EGYPT MA-RINE in Southold. Have **YOU** taken this 8 hour course and Exam yet? Do YOU have your Card and Certificate? Squadron Elections

Your Squadron selects its officers and other elected leaders via a democratic manner. This year, the annual meeting will be in person on Thursday, 20 March 2025, at MYLES ON MAIN Restaurant in Riverhead. The Meeting will begin @ 1900 hrs. Elections will be conducted to select the Bridge Officers and also the Members of the Executive Committee (members at large). In addition, members of the Audit, Rules and Nominating Committees will be elected. The proposed slate of candidates will be sent out to our membership, for the purpose of notification to the general membership prior to the election, as required in the squadron Bylaws, Article 9, Section 9.3. Please note: There are OPEN positions. Any active squadron member, as provided for in Section I 1.1, can nominate other candidates. Under our Bylaws, a member wishing to place in nomination, a candidate or candidates, must document this action by a written petition to the Squadron Secretary. The petition must be signed by at least 5 active members and must be filed with the Secretary at least 15 days prior to the election. The Secretary in turn, must notify the membership of candidates nominated in this manner, at least 7 days prior to the election. Finally, it should be noted that Section 9.7 of our Bylaws requires that a minimum of 10 percent of our current membership needs to be present at the meeting in order to constitute a quorum. We are at approximately 54 members now, so a minimum of 5 active members needs to be present. Thank You,

Get ready for the 2025 boating season and meet the new state regulations, by taking

America's Boating Course

Under the new law, <u>ALL</u> operators of motor boats must have completed a state approved safety course, regardless of age, beginning in 2025 Failure to comply could result in a fine of between \$100 and \$250. The new law does not apply to operators of sailboats under sail, rowboats, canoes or kayaks. America's Boating Course is the most comprehensive course that meets the law.

The course will cover:

Boating law
Safety equipment
Safe boating practices
Boating emergencies
Personal watercraft

Navigation Charts GPS Trailering

& much more

Students receive an America's Boating Course manual, and after passing an exam, a completion certificate and wallet card.

Many insurance companies offer discounts to boaters with completion certificates. (Students must be at least 10 years of age on or before 3/23/25)
